## Andrews provide heating solution for UK's largest postal service

During the festive season, post offices are at their busiest – with loved ones sending letters and gifts all over the world just in time for Christmas. So, when one of the UK's largest courier and postal services experienced temperature issues in their warehouse earlier this month, they contacted Andrews Heat for Hire.

The branch in question is one of the oldest facilities in East Anglia and has historically provided mail collection and delivery services across the UK. The rapid decline in temperature left dozens of workers exposed to uncomfortable working conditions, meaning immediate action was required. A temporary heating arrangement was requested to warm a sizeable working space during a critical period.

Our specialists were drafted in to provide the customer with an effective heating solution to keep productivity at a constant level. After calculating the volume of the application, it was recommended that instead of heating the entire premises, it would be cheaper and more efficient to heat the staff working areas.

Two portable ID65 oil heaters were subsequently delivered to site along with ducting and a 1,000-litre fuel tank to keep the units functional throughout each working day. The tailored heating package worked perfectly and ensured all staff could continue work within a comfortable and productive indoor environment.
