Andrews Air Conditioning Hire provide animal shelter with emergency cooling

An iconic pet shelter recently contacted us in search of an air conditioning hire package to reduce temperatures in various parts of the building.

The UK-based charity has been providing support to dogs and cats for more than a century and a half and are responsible for homing more than 7,000 animals every single year.

During the recent heatwave, the shelter struggled to maintain a desirable environment within the building which in turn left the animals vulnerable to potentially becoming anxious and unwell. As a result, our experts visited site within hours of enquiry to recommend a short-term cooling solution to counteract temperatures and prevent the animals suffering distress.

Our experts proposed and installed several Double Cool air conditioning units which they positioned directly inside areas where the animals were housed. Each unit provided a constant stream of fresh cooled air and ensured every animal located in the vicinity was protected against excessive warmth. These units were chosen because of their ability to produce large airflows as well as their incredible portability, which meant each enclosure could be cleaned just as easily as was the case before our kit was installed.

Our customer was extremely impressed with our temporary air conditioners which played a pivotal role in guaranteeing the continued safety of every single animal.
